



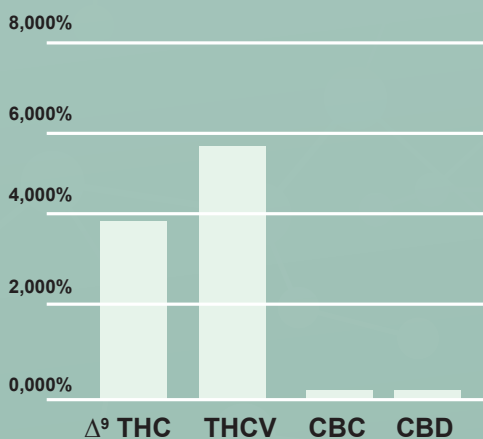

What are cannabis terpenes?
